3. What is the main command Jesus has in these verses? How do "going" and "making disciples" work together?
4. What is the specific purpose Jesus has for us as a local church? Do you see yourself, and our church, like how the church is described in Acts or Thessalonica? Why or why not? What can we do to be more like the biblical prescription and description of the church?
5. It was said that the Great Commission flows from experiencing the risen Jesus Christ, and having a worshipful heart? Do you see these characteristics in your life?
6. Are you growing spiritually in discipleship and making disciples? Do you see yourself bearing fruits of the Spirit? Why or why not?
7. Are you willingly repenting of sins lately? Do you know why this is important?
